PLAN NO. LOCATION DETAILS

17/02932/LBC Warbrook House Reading Road

Relocation of the main entrance of the building (back to its original location), including new entrance doors and replacement black painted metal handrails to entrance steps; creation of a spa area, including treatment rooms and accessible rooms; erection of a single storey side extension to provide a new accessible entrance to the north of the

spa and incorporating a new reception room; conversion of the Peony room back to a bedroom; conversion of second floor Syndicate rooms and Breakout area provide two new two-bedroom family suites; and associated internal alterations.

17/02931/FUL Warbrook House Reading Road

Single storey side extension to provide new spa and accessible entrance and a new reception room to the north of the existing spa facility, the provision of new entrance doors to the new main entrance and the provision of black painted metal handrails to the steps serving the new main entrance to replace the existing handrails.
